The moderate Autumn temperatures of the region ripen the grapes slowly and maximize the typical flavors of tropical fruits and that distinct touch of gooseberry tartness.

Palate: Upfront flavors of pineapple and passion fruit have a distinct gooseberry overlay. Juicy acidity of limes. Full flavored and well balanced. Long finish.
